SENATE BILL NO. 169

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 18 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO LICENSING OF INSURANCE PRODUCERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

Section 1. Amend § 1706, Title 18 of the Delaware Code as follows:

§ 1706. Application for license.

(b) (1) Any person applying for a resident license, whether a resident applicant or a nonresident applicant that has declared Delaware to be his or her home state, shall submit fingerprints and other necessary information to the State Bureau of Identification in order to obtain all of the following:

a. A report of the person's entire criminal history record from the State Bureau of Identification or a statement from the State Bureau of Identification that the State Bureau of Identification Central Repository contains no such information relating to that person.

b. A report of the person's entire federal criminal history from the Federal Bureau of Investigation pursuant to the Federal Bureau of Investigation appropriation of Title II of Public Law 92-544 (28 U.S.C. § 534) or a statement that the Federal Bureau of Investigation's records contain no such information relating to that person.

(2) The State Bureau of Identification shall be the intermediary for purposes of this section and the Department shall be the screening point for the receipt of federal criminal history reports required by paragraph (b)(1)b. of this section.

(3) The State Bureau of Identification shall forward all information obtained under this subsection to the Department.

(4) A person required to obtain criminal history reports under this subsection is responsible for any costs associated with obtaining the criminal history reports.
